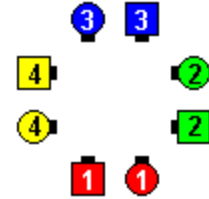

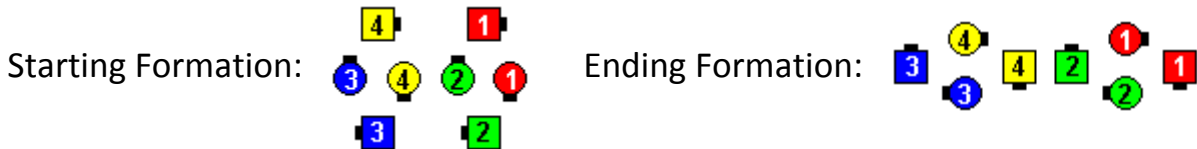
This is a squared set with everyone standing at Home:



Here's an example of "All Position Dancing"

Dance action of Fan The Top: The centers turn three quarters (270°) while the outside dancers move forward in a quarter circle.

The following shows what happens when Fan The Top is called from Diamonds:



- The dancers are in Parallel Diamonds before Fan The Top is called.
- The dancers end in Point-To-Point Diamonds after Fan The Top.

This will seem awkward at first, but you will soon be dancing it smoothly.

"Dancing By Definition" takes things a step further:

For example, the call could be "Do The First 3 Parts of Load The Boat":



Look interesting? This will exercise your brain.

It's definitely not for everyone. If you are interested, and if you can put the time into learning it, you will experience a whole new world of challenging choreography and fun.
