Directions: From (Mass Pike) Rt. 90 East or West Exit 4 Holyoke to Rt. 91. Go North to Exit 16 either North or South. Turn onto Rt. 202 South, go to traffic light. Turn left onto Homestead Ave 202 South. Then right at flashing yellow light onto Holyoke Community College campus. Turn right and drive 3/4 of a mile till you reach the top and you are at the circle and flagpole. Park in the visitor lot (Donohue Building) and look for the square dance sign.
